ABI/Inform

Identifies articles on business, finance, and management topics from regional, the U.S. and international publications. Besides current information, includes archives of many important scholarly journals in business covering different aspects of business information, such as scholarly research, business traditions and trends, corporate strategies, management techniques, and competitive and product information.

Business Source Complete

Identifies scholarly information from business-related journals, books, conference proceedings and more. Non-journal content includes financial data, books, monographs, major reference works, book digests, conference proceedings, case studies, investment research reports, industry reports, market research reports, country reports, company profiles, and SWOT (strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats) analyses.

EconLit

Identifies articles, books, dissertations, and working papers in economics. The database covers the literature in accounting, capital markets, econometrics, economic forecasting, government regulations, labor economics, agricultural and natural resource economics, environmental and ecological economics, urban economics and more.
