Includes an introductory essay that places modern Japanese politics within a historical framework, an essay summarizing the major theories of Japanese politics, and approximately 250 short entries on various related topics. The dictionary format lends itself more to browsing than to focused study, and the text would likely be most useful for undergraduate or graduate students who are beginning exploration of the topic. Each dictionary entry provides references for further reading, and the work includes a bibliography and index.

The work includes a bibliography and a comprehensive index.

Articles are based on primary sources and include bibliographies.

The fourth volume also includes primary source documents related to the entries, the ***CSGR Globalisation Index*** that measures dimensions of globalization per country, and an additional selected bibliography arranged by subject areas.
