## ICA SUV Online Biography – Instructions and Descriptive Fields for Writers of Biographical Entries

- Biographies can be about living or deceased individuals who <u>substantially</u> advanced the archival field in theoretical and practical ways. Therefore, they do not necessarily have to be archivists; they might be historians for example.
- You cannot submit an entry about yourself.
- You have to **let us know ahead of time about whom** you are planning to write in case someone else is already working on a submission about that same individual. Once the editorial board gives you the goahead, you will have three months to submit your text. After three months, your planned submission will be cancelled and someone else's proposal might be accepted. We will not accept proposals or submissions about individuals already included in the online biography site.
- The editorial board will decide which submissions will be accepted. Decisions are final.
- Submission has to be a word document. Fields marked with an asterisk \* are mandatory; for fields marked with f see note below. All other fields are optional and recommended: whenever possible you should try to provide all the details asked for.
- Quotes have to include precise reference to author/title/publication if/publisher/year/location/page
- Submissions and online entries will be in English only since ICA-SUV lacks the volunteers to provide translations. However, once we have edited and approved a submission, you are welcome to also provide us with a translation of the text into your **national language**, which we will make available online.
