Look and Feel

- The online biographical entries will be accessible as pdfs. The pdf will include all fields of entry (once we have your comments on those) and I will design a basic, okay looking page which all submitters and then editorial board members can use.
- It will be a simple layout and have short entries (check out the dictionary of Canadian Biography Online to get an idea: <http://www.biographi.ca/009004-111.01-e.php?brws=1&start=D&end=E&PHPSESSID=eq89fa15jgiuo0p4k58eod6so5>). Or look at Who's Who online....
- These will be short online bios and therefore include only some elements more typical for record creators.
- We will create a simple website with a short introductory text, links to submitted entries, EB policy, guidelines and all other things needed.
- The website will list the alphabet, clicking on a letter will get you to a page listing all last names under that letter. When clicking on to a particular last name you get a pdf with the biographical info of one archivist. If the entry exists in several languages, those files would be listed here.
- The schema table listing all descriptive fields IS NOT how the information will be presented online. We will create paragraph style text with a few separate entries (such as date of birth).
