#### LCAP election coming October 1

LCAP has been working to expand our constituency to include reclassified Academic Professional positions. Part of this expansion includes adding people in those positions to the ballot and eligibility list. We want to ensure the Library's definitions of these positions matches those of the campus, which are still being revised, and we are delaying the 2021 L-CAP election until October 1 in the hope campus definitions will be resolved in time. One way or the other, the election will go forward, October 1.

L-CAP has seven elected members who serve two-year terms. Council of Academic Professionals reps from the Library also serve as ex-officio members of L-CAP. We hold a regular business meeting monthly, and meet with Dean Wilkin quarterly. We organize an AP forum annually, distribute the AP Update newsletter, host occasional social meetups, and advise Library administration on issues such as the AP promotion program, investigation time, and campus actions affecting APs (such as position reclassifications). L-CAP has increasingly been involved in Library governance through direct feedback to Dean Wilkin and the Library Executive Committee. An L-CAP member serves on the Inclusion in Governance Task Force. In the October election, **three seats will be open for 2021-2023**, and we encourage you to keep your name on the ballot!
