Received papers of admission, had corn meal cakes (baked in the oven) for breakfast with a little mutton, the same for dinner with gravy made of water flour salt pepper and lard for supper Bakers bread and butter. Felt the same as Ben Franklin did when he lived on porridge.

Received box provision from home pie, meat, butter, preserves, cookies & co bought a botany and Chemistry, went to Urbana for the first time worked 7 hour & 36 min. had beefsteak for supper. lost 2 lbs during the week ending Saturday the 11 weigh 135 lbs
