- > Applicants must secure adequate funding to support a stay at the Mortenson Center in order to be accepted into the program.
- > Program is delivered in English only, and participants should be fluent in conversational English and possess a reading knowledge of English.



COST

The program cost covers housing, some meals, local transportation, program costs and medical insurance. It does not cover expenses for visa application, and transportation to and from Champaign-Urbana. The 2020 program cost was \$4,000, and the final cost for 2021 is to be determined.
