

Scholarly Communications Lifecycle

Topic:

Develop a systematic program of services and tools that supports the full life cycle of scholarly communications.

Themes:

Instruction:

- Focus on introducing graduate students to concept and practice of OA; work with them to articulate their role in practicing OA in their discipline with their colleagues & publishers
- SC basics for undergrads as part of their library orientation?

Training & outreach:

- Host “SC communications training day” in Library to train faculty and staff
- Update SC-related web sites, including IDEALS documentation

Copyright & IP:

- Address needs for copyright consultations on complex authorship & re-use questions
- Provide more robust & knowledgeable support for researchers who need to negotiate with publishers for access to text/data corporae for research

Facilities:

- Address access/use barriers with physical objects in archives—need appropriate research space
