- Suggestions based on debriefing:
 - Need to work on creating linkages to faculty teaching undergrads. Subject specialists tend to have good connections with the graduates.
 - Recommend starting with linking to library web pages (at least get faculty doing that)
 - Send e-mails to faculty and TA's at the beginning of the semester (and a month before??) to ask them to put the librarian's name, e-mail and web address in the syllabus and their course web page (or management system etc.)
 - Some folks have all faculty using compass and some have none. The emphasis for the committee should be about course integration (in any way-- not just with any particular course management system).
 - Would like to explore other digital approaches emerging and push them out to faculty too.
